



A Draught of a Tract of land called \_\_\_\_\_ situate on the Waters of Shamokin Creek about three quarters of a mile to the Eastward of land surveyed for Edw. Biddle Esq. James Starr and Benjamin Eightfoot and to the Northward of the Provincial Road leading from Francis Yarnells to Fort Augusta Sunbury &c in the County of Northumberland containing one hundred and seventeen Acres and one hundred and thirty six Perches besides the usual allowance of six per Cent for Roads &c surveyed the 4<sup>th</sup> Day of November 1775 for Michael Thompson in Pursuance of a Warrant Dated the 28<sup>th</sup> Day of September 1775
