



By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated March 1st 1734th Surveyed to John Keenard a certain tract of Land situate on a Branch of Schickon Called the Deep Run in the County of Bucks Beginning at a Hickory in William Allens line thence by Vact Land North East one Hundred and forty one perches to a post thence by Vacant Land South East one hundred and twenty perches to a post a Corner of Joseph Townsend's land thence by the same South West one hundred and forty one perches to a post in the line of S. Allens land thence by the same North West one hundred & twenty perches to the place of Beginning - Containing one hundred Acres with usual allowance of six per cent -
