I further state that the said Young in addition to his said warrant claims the said Land by his improvements consisting of about 1/2 acre Land lately cleared & fenced, but no grain raised, including a small cabin containing 11 feet 8 inches by 8 feet 5 inches & 5 feet in height to the top of the rafters covered with a few split rails, all which is respectfully submitted to the surveyor General
