



Situate in York Township, in the County of York, and containing as above set forth 85° 42' 50" and allowance. - Being part of a larger tract of land originally surveyed on the 5th day of Nov^r 1756 by George Stevenson late D.S. in pursuance of a Warrant granted to John Bush, bearing date the 19th of May 1752. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract on the 20th day of April 1757 by John Forsyth late D.S. And now, after having been carefully examined corrected and calculated, it is, at the request of the present owner Peter Diehl, returned for Confirmation the 2th day of August Anno Domini 1809.
