



Situate in Warrington Township York County, Containing as above set forth 21⁰ 1/2 115¹/₂ Perches and allowance of six Per Cent &c. Being part of a larger tract of 29⁰ 1/2 25 Perches and allowance &c of land surveyed by the late Thomas Amos late D.S. under George Stevenson late D.S. on the 9th day of March 1775. In pursuance of a warrant Granted to Jacob Stickle bearing date the 7th day of October AD^o 1774. The above Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract of land at the request of the owner James Harris, who desired the same to be returned for Confirmation the 5th day of January Anno Domini 1810.—
