Being part of a larger tract of 210<sup>acs</sup> & allowance, which was originally surveyed by George Stevenson late D.S. on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of October AD<sup>o</sup> 1752. for Heathias Burgett. In pursuance of a Warrant bearing date the 18<sup>th</sup> day of December 1751. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract of land the 24<sup>th</sup> & 25<sup>th</sup> days of October Anno Domini 1809. for Jacob Rehman Senr. the present owner, who desired me to make return of the draught for Confirmation. -
