



Situated on the Waters of Dunkap's Creek in Franallin Township Fayette County and surveyed the 1st day of February 1835 in consequence of a Certificate issued by the Commissioners appointed by the State of Virginia to settle the Claims to unpatented lands in the Counties of Monongalia Johogania & Ohio of which the following is a true Copy —

We the Commissioners appointed for adjusting the Claims to unpatented lands in the Counties of Monongalia Johogania and Ohio do hereby Certify that George Craft is entitled to four hundred acres of land in the County of Monongalia on the waters of Dunkap's Creek to include his Settlement, made in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and seventy two also one thousand Acres in right of Preemption adjoining thereto
 Given under our hands at Reston on the 18th day of December 1839 in the fourth year of the Commonwealth
