



Situate on the West side of Kanawhela River at James Crawford's Ferry above the Mouth of Fishpot Dam in Washington County and surveyed in part in the year 1782 and finished the 25<sup>th</sup> day of April 1785, in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 26<sup>th</sup> day of January 1774, which survey is now enlarged from 93<sup>1/2</sup> to 108<sup>1/2</sup> and allowance, at the particular Request and Desire of ~~the said~~ James Crawford <sup>who claims under Ephraim</sup> he pleading that his Warrant which is for 100<sup>00</sup> was not fully satisfied by the former survey and the same being Casated by David Blair as will be seen by a Book in the Margin of the former Return "he alleges an equal Right to contest for the full quantity, to which he was intitled by his Warrant: you will please to Judge of the propriety of acceptance —
