



Pursuant to a Warrant dated the 28th day of March 1788 the above described tract of Land Beginning at a corner of Land of Joseph Millard & by land of John Lewis S 6° E 112 p to a post & N 84° E 154 p & by land of Thomas Millard S 6° E 10 p to a corner of land of Charles Packington & by same S 84° W 154 p N 51 1/2° W 92 p to a marked gum tree S 73 1/2° W 90 p to a post & N 84° W 52 to a stone & by land of Joseph & Samuel McElduff N 4° E 69 p to a stone & by same & Land of Joseph Millard N 86° E 110 p to a chest N 4° W 14 p & N 86° E 82 p to the place of Beginning Containing 93 1/2 acres & allowance was Surveyed to James Templin on the 14th day of March 1789 in West March (Twp. Chester County) To Sam Cochran Esq. Surveyor General of Penns. Charles Dilworth D.S.
