T. B. I do hereby Certify that the Improvements made on the lands intended to be covered by the above mentioned Warrant consisting of a dwelling House, Barn & Stable, rendering it an actual personal Settlement with a manifest intention of making it a place of abode and means of Supporting a family; are just within the bounds of the Manor of Springetsbury. But that the greater part of the above Tract is cleared, and that the above as well as the part within the Manor whereon the Buildings stand, was held & peaceably enjoyed as one plantation
