



Situate in Manchester Township in the County of York, containing as above set forth One Acre and One Hundred and thirty seven perches and Allowance, Surveyed the 12th day of August A.D. 1812, in pursuance of a Warrant for 4th granted to John Schus dated the 18th day of March 1812.

N.B. The improvement on the above described piece of land at the time the Warrant was issued it is said was a Log dwelling House with a family living in it, and all the land cleared part thereof in meadow. But at the time of Surveying the same, nothing of the building remained, it having been torn down previous to the survey above mentioned.
