



Situate in Chanceford Township in the County of York. Containing as above set forth 22 a & 152 Perches and the usual allowance of 6 P. Cent &c. Surveyed on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of May AD. 1815. In Pursuance of a Warrant for 25<sup>a</sup> granted to James Douglass bearing date the 30<sup>th</sup> day of July AD. 1814.

N.B. The Improvement on the above described Land at the time of Surveying were some cleared Land without any Building thereon, and that made prior to the 28<sup>th</sup> day of March 1814. -
