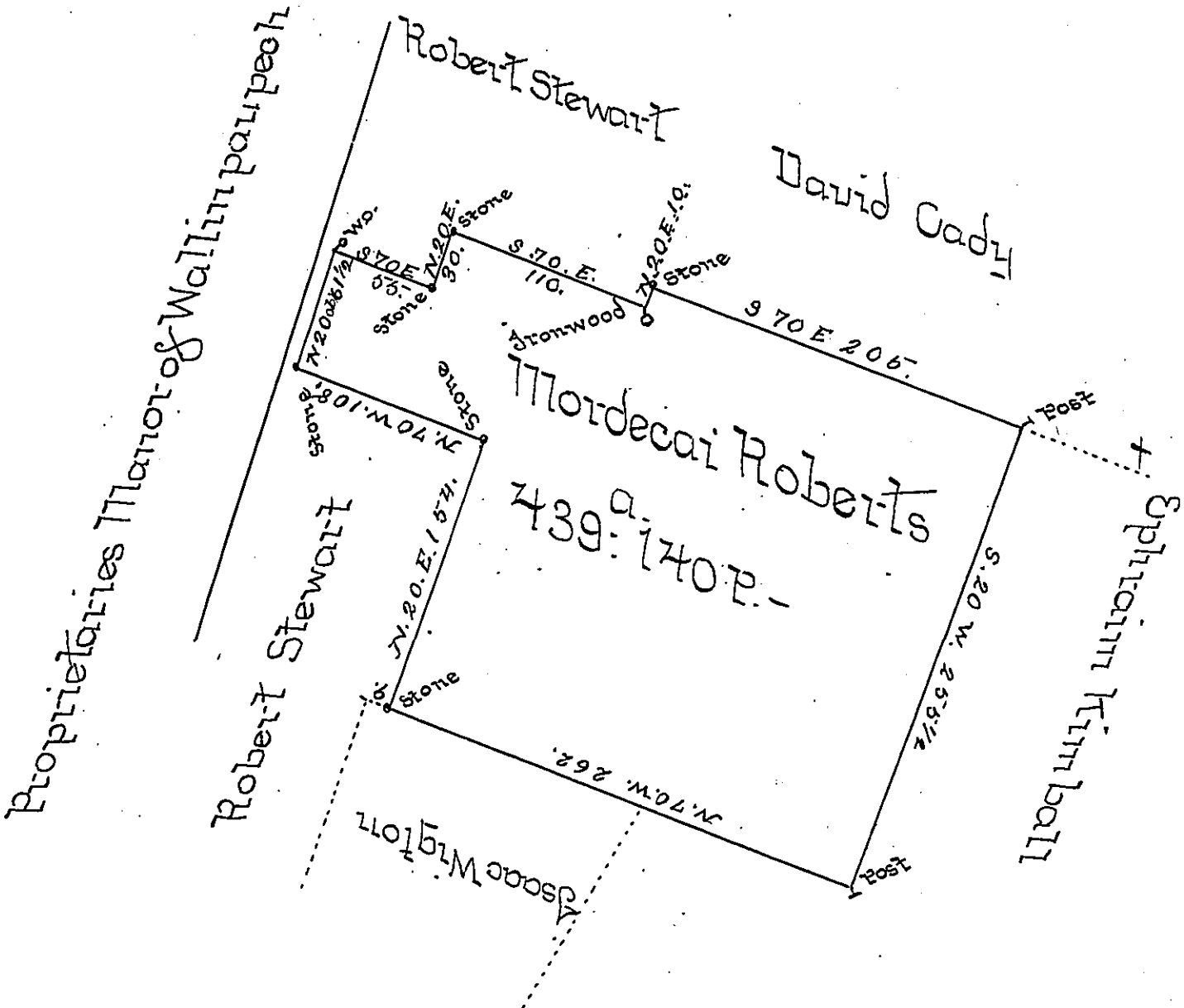


Palmyra -

By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 22<sup>d</sup> December 1792 Surveyed the 3<sup>d</sup> November 1793 to Mordecai Roberts the above described tract of land situate on the head Waters of Washboms run about three miles from Leehawaxen River in the County of Northampton Containing four hundred and thirty nine Acres one hundred and forty perches and the allowance of Six Percent &c -
