



A Draught of a Tract of Land, situate in Sugarloaf Town-  
 ship Columbia County; surveyed 26<sup>th</sup> September 1811 unto  
 Hannah Montgomery by Virtue of her Warrant dated the  
 28<sup>th</sup> day of April 1794 containing 361 Acres & thirty per-  
 ches and Allowance &c. which was since found to inter-  
 fere with an Older Survey under the Warrantee name  
 of Thomas Strawbridge and upon Petition of Gilbert Hess  
 the present owner, the Board of Property, granted an  
 Order of Resurvey dated February 6<sup>th</sup> 1861 for the purpose  
 of excluding all interferences Resurveyed February 11<sup>th</sup>  
 1861 in pursuance of said Order of Resurvey and found  
 the same to contain Three Hundred and Seventeen Acres  
 and Twenty one perches and Allowance of Six per cent<sup>r</sup>  
 for Roads &c. Clear of all interference. By
