Cullery and Mr. John Johnston two respectable Gentlemen chosen by Francis Wilson, Carr Powell & Hugh McDonald to lay off their Land so as to make it most convenient for each of them. Surveyed the above described Tract of Land for Francis Wilson containing Three Hundred & Thirty Acres & 13 1/2 perches with an allowance proportion to six Acres 236 Acres & 67 perches of the above described Tract of Land was on the 14<sup>th</sup> Dec<sup>r</sup> 1785 in pursuance of Warrant dated May 18<sup>th</sup> 1785 - Surveyed to the said Francis Wilson Survey March 7<sup>th</sup> 1788.
