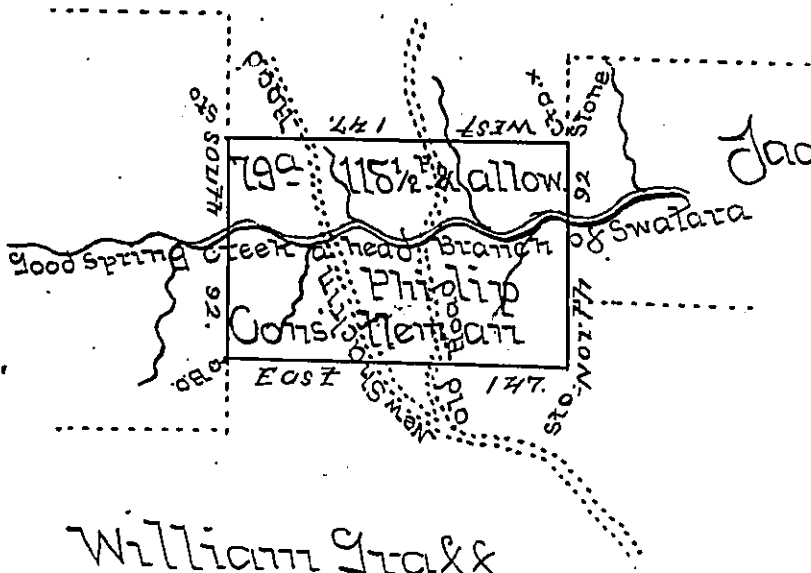

Situate in Lower Mahoningo Township Schuylkill County containing 79a 115 1/2 & allowance of six percent for Roads &c. surveyed on the 12. of October. A.D. 1829. by virtue of a Warrant granted to Philip Constelman (Callias Kuntzelman) bearing date the 15th day of May A.D. 1776. - By

By the line trees in the above Survey, it appears that the original Survey was made in 1783 or 1784. - no Draught to show the date of the original Survey -- No improvement of any kind on the land, except several Coal Stratas opened the above tract. was was for many years an isolated Survey. until other Surveys was adjoined to it. it is also covered with a Warrant granted to John Miller. Esq. in 1793. in the name of John Witman -
