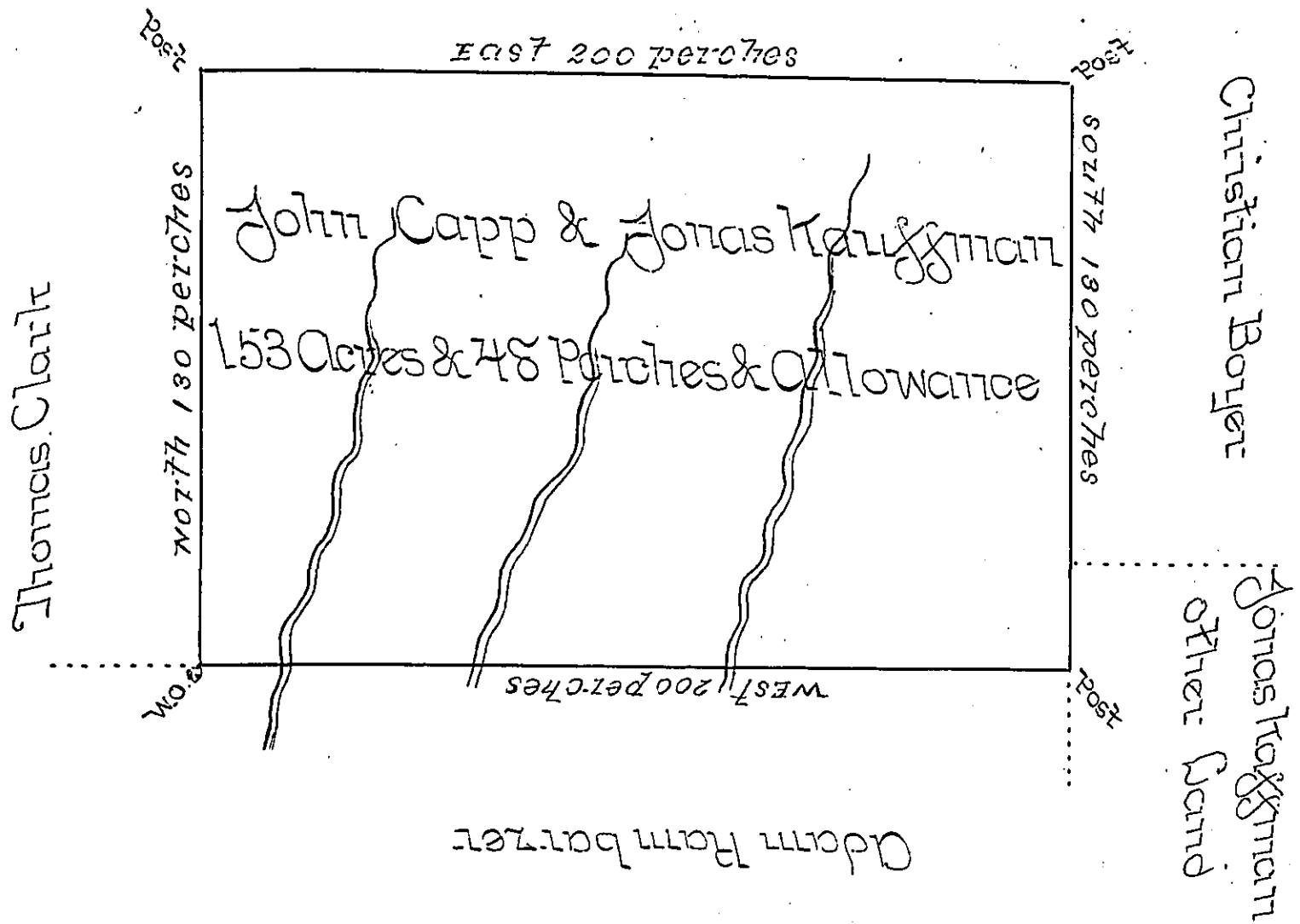


Vacant Land



By Virtue of a Warrant dated the Twenty Second day of February 1750 Surveyed the 23<sup>d</sup> day of May 1750 to John Capp and Jonas Kauffman the above Described Tract of Land Situate over the Blue Mountain on several small Branches of Pine Creek in the County of Berks Containing one Hundred and Fifty Three Acres & 48 Perches and Allowance of Six Percent for Floods &c.
