



A Draft of a tract of land situate in Upper Milford Town-  
 ship in the County of Northampton said to be Origin-  
 ally surveyed to Peter Keiler, by Warrant dated the 1<sup>st</sup>  
 November 1745 containing one hundred and thirty  
 five Acres an half and the allowance of six <sup>p</sup> Cent for  
 formerly divided between Jacob Bortz Adam Miller  
 and Philip Weitzell.

The small piece marked Abraham Gethman was sur-  
 veyed from Adam Miller's part the 21<sup>st</sup> January 1807.  
 containing three Acres an half and the allowance of six  
 p Cent for Gethman.
