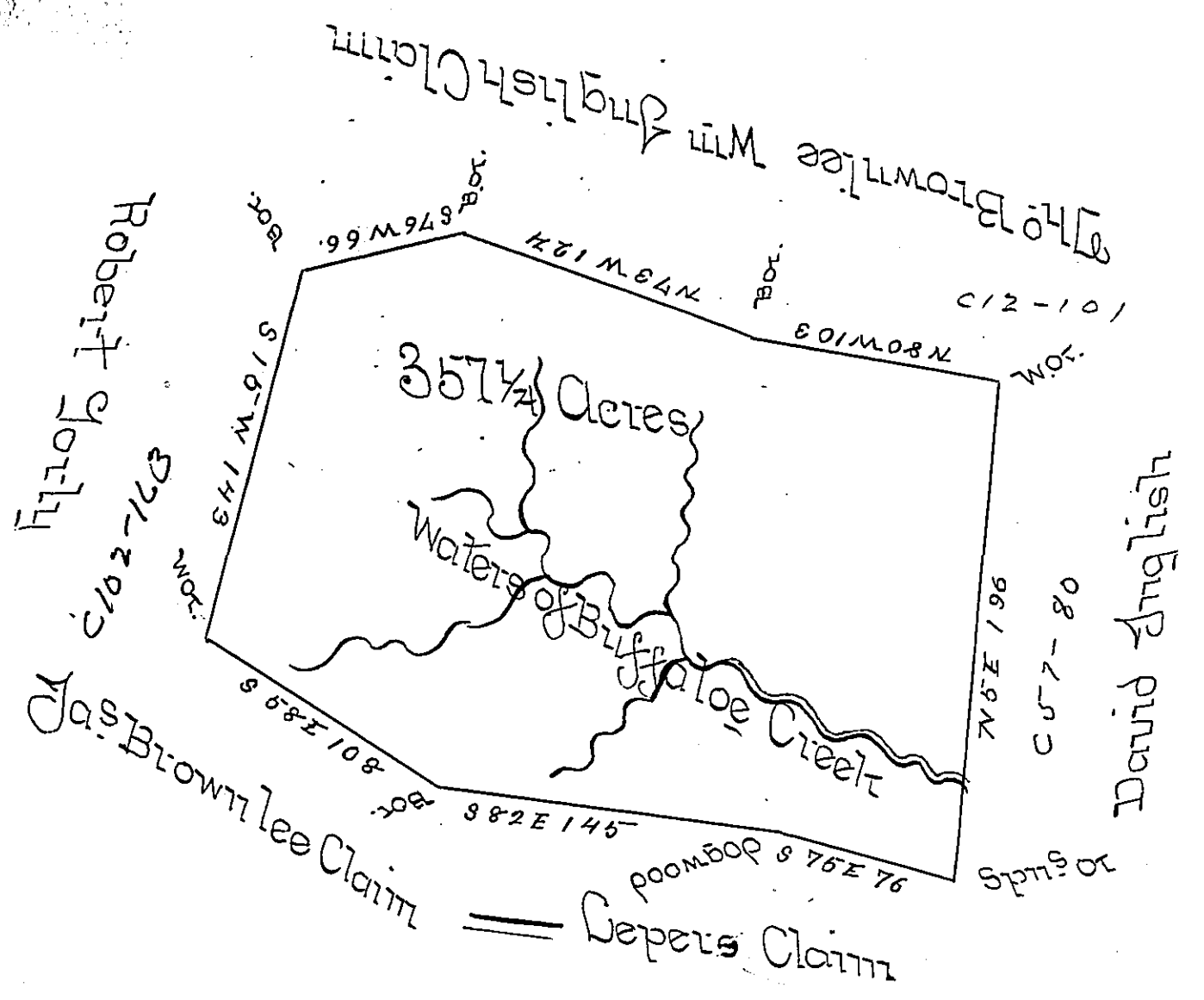


Entd March 1750 by the name of Wm English
