A Draught of a tract of land situate in Parris Township in the County of Northumberland surveyed the 4<sup>th</sup> of Dec<sup>r</sup> 1785 by W<sup>m</sup> Gray D.S. & Resurveyed the 4<sup>th</sup> of August 1795 for John Row in pursuance of his Warrant bearing date the 4<sup>th</sup> day of May 1773 containing Seventy one Acres & one hundred & sixty two Perches & Allowances.
