



In pursuance of an Order No 395 dated the 3d of April 1769 Surveyed for John Williams ^{Sr} the above described tract of land (called Bealy's Delight) containing three hundred & two acres & 62 perches with an allowance proportioned to 6 Percent. Situate about twenty miles from Pittsburg near the West Branch of Turtle Creek. Adjoining the lands of Hugh Davidson & Wm Menoch now in Westmoreland County.

Surveyed May the 12th 1772. P.
