



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries Dated the second day of February 1733 Surveyed unto John Fisher a Tract of Land situate in Plumsted Township in the County of Bucks Beginning at a post in the line of Matthew Hughes ^{Junr} Land thence by the same North West Seventy perches to a post thence by Vacant Land North East one hundred and Twenty Two perches to a Black Oak thence by Vacant Land South East Seventy perches to a Black Oak in the line of Nehemiah Blackshaw Land thence by the same South West one hundred and Twenty Two perches to the place of Beginning containing fifty acres with usual Allowance of Six Percent
 Surveyed June 4th 1734
