



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries Dated the Third day of September 1736 Resurveyed to Thomas & George Fitzwater the above Described Tract of Land situate in Whitpain Township in the County of Philada Beginning at a White Oak a Corner of Anthony Morris's Land thence by the same SW 498 perches to a post thence by the Manor of William Stad SE 120 perches to a post thence by the Lands of Humphrey Ellis & William Robeson NW 498 perches to a Stone thence by land of sd Anthony Morris NW 120 perches to the place of Beginning Containing 352 Acres with the usual Allowance of Six Percent -
