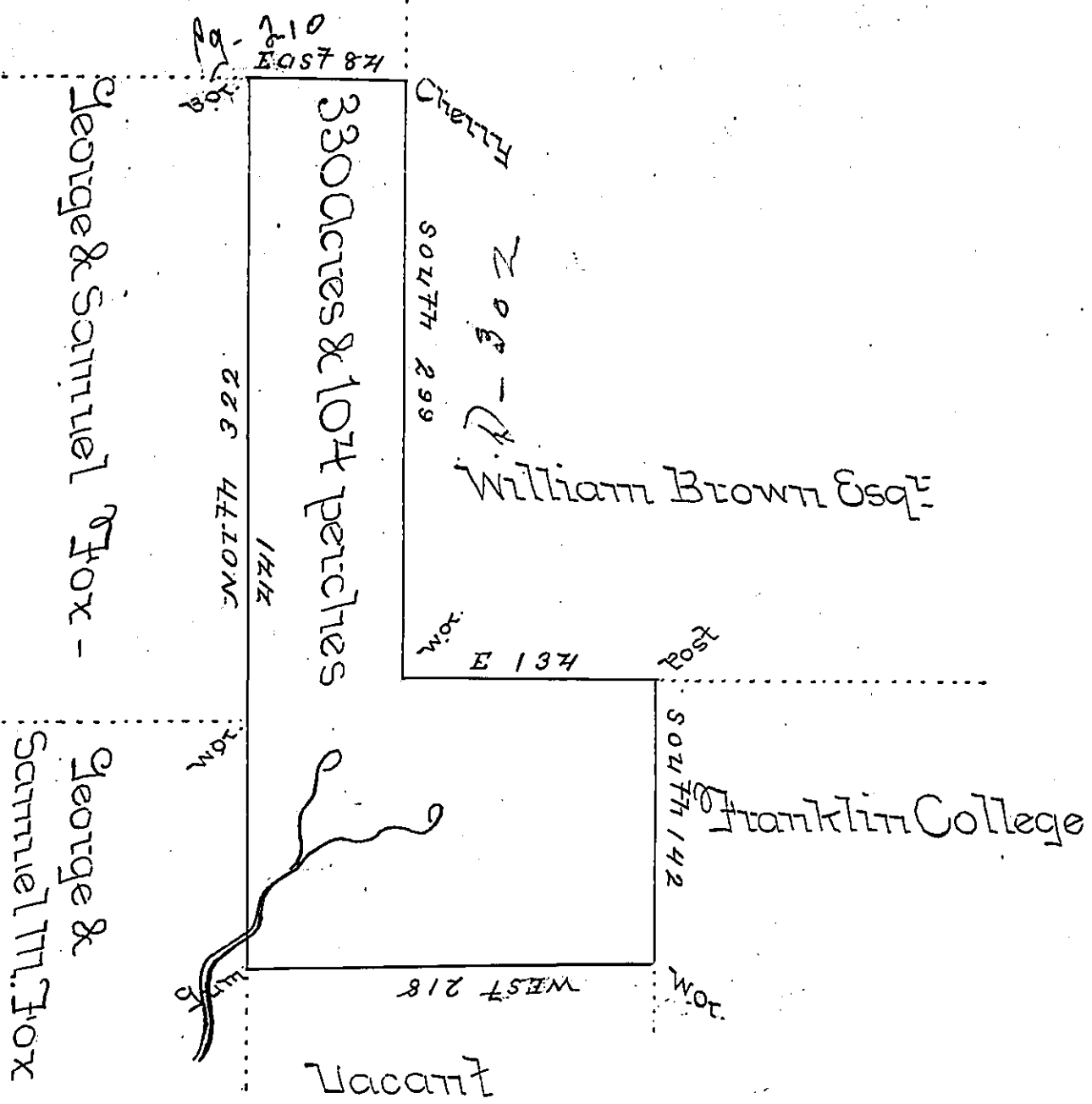


Franklin College No



Surveyd the Above Described Tract of land on the 19th day of July 1787 for the Trustees of Franklin College Containing Three Hundred and thirty Acres and One hundred and four perches with the Usual Allowance of Six p^t C^t & c^t Situate and lying about ten miles niles North of the Mouth of Tobys Creek and about six miles East of the Allegheny River and Adjoining Lands of George and Samuel Michael Foxs and William Brown Esq^t late purchase Northumberland County in pursuance of a Warrant granted them from the Land Office on the 14th day of June 1787 Number 804 -
