Wohogania and Ohio do Hereby Certify that Richard Yates is
 entitled to four Hundred Acres of Land in the County of Ohio
 on the Waters of Shirtee Creek to include his Settlement Pur-
 chased of John M^c Collock made in the year of our Lord one
 thousand Seven Hundred & seventy two then under our Hands
 at Redstone old for the sixteenth Day of December 1779 in the
 fourth year of the Commonwealth
