



A Draft of a Tract of Land situate in Antrim Township in the County of Franklin Containing four hundred & twenty eight acres and an allowance of the sp. Cent for Roads &c. (Exclusive of the piece marked A which contains eight acres & an half, claimed by William Rankin) Surveyed May 12th 1785 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Andrew Robinson bearing Date the 6th Day of December 1784.

N.B. I have seen a draft of an old Survey of the above Lands said to have been made on a Warrant to John M. Cune Dated in the year 1753. But it is strongly alledged by Mr. Robinson that no such Warrant exists, also Purford says that repeated Searches have been made in the Surveyor Generals Office for such Warrant, and none found. I have not hitherto been able to obtain certain Knowledge of the foundation of Mr. Rankins claim above mentioned
