The above Survey was made in Pursuance of a Warrant bearing Date the 17<sup>th</sup> of October, 1755. Granted in the Name of Benjamin Dilworth & Robert McMin; at the Time of Survey Robert McMin (who appeared to me to be the Proper Owner & Possessor of the land) expressed his uneasiness at Dilworth's Name being in the Warrant, and said it was without his Knowledge or consent, requesting that the name of Robert McMin <sup>only</sup> should be inserted in the Return. The Land lies on the Branches of Peter's Creek in Little Britain <sup>or</sup> (Perhaps Part) in Drummore Township Lancaster County Certified By
