S. on the 12th of the 8th mo = 1790. In pursuance of a Warrant for 100^{ac} Granted to Martha Finley Widow bearing date the 16th day of June 1786 - Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land for Philip Bowman present owner the 24th day of February A.D. 1807. who desired us to make Return of the Draught.
