Survey'd in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Samuel Rippey bearing Date the 3<sup>d</sup> Day of June 1762 - N<sup>o</sup>. 2 Containing thirty acres and the allowance aforesaid, Survey'd in pursuance of a Warrant granted to the said Samuel Rippey bearing date the 26<sup>th</sup> Day of March 1767 - Resurvey'd January 29<sup>th</sup> 1781.
