



Hugh McKnight claims 17 3/4 ac within the dotted lines & requested it to be returned in Dispute

A Draught of a survey called "The Compact" situate on the West Fork of Chartiers Crk in Washington County containing 315.99 ac strict measure, executed March 15th 1788 in consequence of a Cert^{ificat} for 400 ac granted to Wm. Crawford by the Commiss^{rs} appointed by Virg^a to adjust the claims to unpatented lands in Monong^a & York^a & Ohio and duly entered & S. Ent^d 9th Feb^r 1780.

Ret^d 28th May 1788

says the owner of this is willing to give up 17 3/4 ac and to obtain two Pat^{ts} the 17 3/4 ac, therefore is left out
