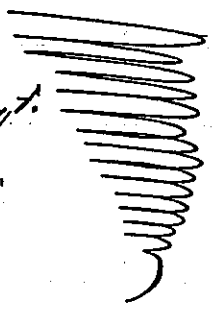


A Draught of a Tract of Land situate on the waters of Brush Creek in
