



A Draught of a Tract of Land called Wheatfield situate about a mile southerly of that part of the West Branch of Susquehanna which is situated halfway between the Mouth of Chest Creek & Clearfield Creek, adjoining Land of William Govett & John Ladd Howell & William Patterson Esq: & Co. on the waters of Clearfield Creek in the County of Bedford, Containing three hundred & one acres & three quarters & the usual allowance of six per Cent for Roads &c. surveyed the 21st day of November 1775 for Joseph Govett in pursuance of a warrant dated the third day of August 1773.
