



By Virtue of a warrant from the Proprietaries dated the fourth day of May 1734
 Surveyed unto Charles Houlshousin a Tract of Land part in the County of Philadelphia
 & part in the County of Bucks situate in New cowissloppen. Beginning at a
 post a corner of John Bingamans and thence by land of George Shoemaker North
 fifty eight degrees East one hundred thirty nine perches to a post. thence
 by land of Ureck Rasor North two hundred perches to a post. thence by Va.
 cant Land South West two hundred seventy six to a post thence by Vact.
 land & land of s^r Bingaman South East one hundred & ten perches to the place
 of Beginning. Containing One hundred fifty eight acres with the usual ab-
 rowance of six p^{er} Cent. Surveyed April 24th by
