



In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 22^d day of May 1754. I have surveyed on the 10th day of October 1755 to John Hannam a City Lot appurtenant to the Original purchase of 250 acres of land made by John Nield of the late Proprietary William Penn decd. which said Lot of Ground is situate within the City of Philad^a, between the seventh & eighth streets from Delaware, & between Mulberry street & Sassafras Street. Containing in Breadth Forty nine feet & six inches & in length three hundred and six feet. Bounded Northward by the S. Sassafras Street. Eastward by the said seventh Street from Delaware. Southward by the ends of Mulberry Street Lots & westward by Vacant Ground
