



The above dotted lines describes a tract of Land in Greenwood Township Survey'd on a warrant granted to John Jones dated 10th Sept. 1814 for 75 acres, which only contains 67th 25th and allowance as per Clarke's draft appears — and now at the instance of the said John Jones. Survey'd the above nine acres twenty one perches and allowance in addition to the other survey in order to fill said warrant — amounting to seventy six acres, forty six perches and allowance.
