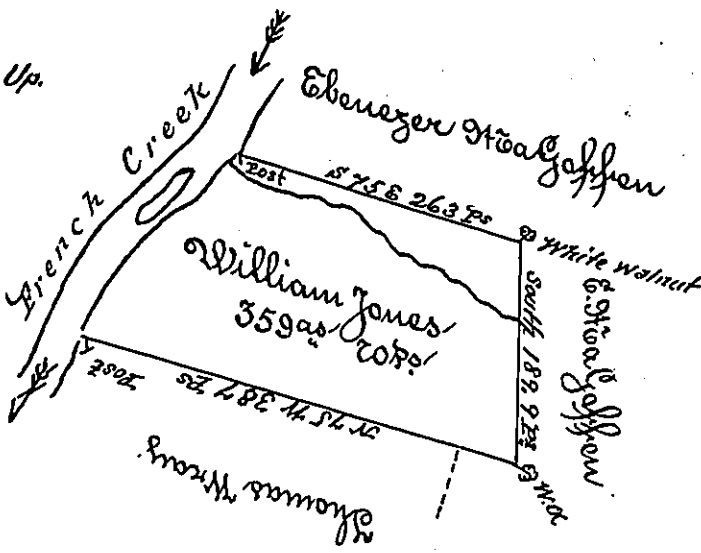

In pursuance of a warrant for 350 acres dated the twentieth day of September AD 1815 was surveyed the fourth day of December AD 1815 for William Jones the above described tract of land containing three hundred fifty nine acres seventy perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c situate on the east side - and adjoining French Creek about four miles above Meadville - Head Township Crawford County Pa and at the time of making the survey the said W^m Jones was in possession of the same and there appeared to be upwards of forty acres of the land cleared fenced and in a good state of cultivation -
