

By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietor Dated the 24th Day of August anno Domini 1732 the above described Tract of Land was surveyed into George Henderson in the Township in Lancaster County Beginning at a stone thence West by South by Vacant Land 130 perches to a White Oak thence North 15 Degrees West by y^e Land of James Canary & Vacant Land 183 perches to a White Oak thence East by South by y^e Land of William Morris 133 perches to a White Oak thence North by West by the same 20 pces to a White Oak thence East by North by the same 50 pces to a stone thence South 10 Degrees East by the lands of Robert Warberton and Nicholas Henderson 128 perches to a Hickory thence West by South by the said Henderson 32 perches to a Hickory thence South by the same 26 perches to y^e place of beginning containing One hundred and Ninety acres beside the allowance of six pcent
