



By virtue of a Warrant from the Commiss^{rs} of Property dated the 18th day of the 5th mo 1715 I have surveyed unto Samuel Heald a certain Tract of Land situate in Rossinet Township in the County of Chester Beginning at a white oak at a Corner of John Battins Land, thence South forty four degrees westerly by the Land of John Coye one hundred & thirty four perches to a Spanish oak, thence North forty six degrees westerly by the same Land twenty three perches to a white oak, thence South forty four degrees westerly by the s^r John Coye's Land 126 perches to a post, thence North West by the Land of Ezekiel Warlan seventy perches to a Hickery, thence North East by the Land of Tho^s Fisher two hundred & sixty one perches to a post thence South East by the Lands of Edward Evans and the s^r John Batten ~~in~~ one hundred & fifty seven perches to the place of Beginning Containing one hundred and seventy seven acres and the usual allowance
