



By Virtue of a warrant from the Hon^{ble} proprietaries bearing date ye^e fourteenth day of September 1732 I have survey'd and laid out unto Nicholas Reed in the Township of Tunkamell in the County of Chester one hundred and forty six Acres of Land wth allowance of six per Cent. Beginning at a white oak a Corner of Simon Merediths Land thence by Land of Duncan Woodrow, one hundred and two perches to a post thence South nineteen Degrees Easterly one hundred and twelve perches to a Chestnut Tree thence South fifty five Degrees Easterly fifteen perches to a white oak thence South nineteen Degrees Easterly Twenty four perches to Spanish Oak thence north seventy one Degrees Easterly one hundred and seventy two perches to a Chestnut Tree thence north nineteen Degrees Easterly one hundred and five perches to a White Oak standing in the Line of the s^d Merediths Land thence by the s^d Land North Eighty Degrees Westerly Eighty seven perches to the place of beginning
