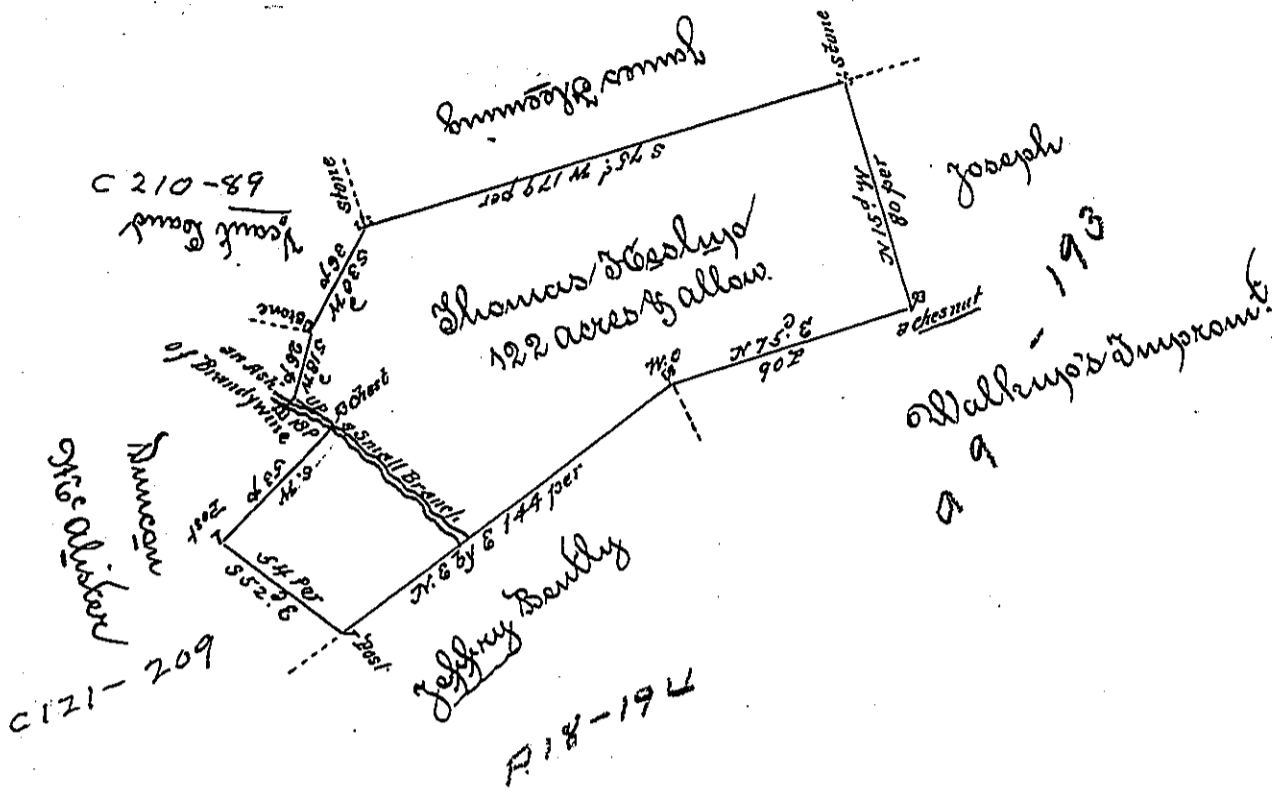

By Virtue of a Warrant Dated the 22nd Day of September Anno Dom. 1744 the above Described Tract of Land was Surveyed to Thomas Deasly in Fallsfield Township in Chester County Beginning at a Whiteoak Corner of Jeffrey Bentley Thence S 75° E by Joseph Walkup's Improvement 90 perches to a Chesnut Thence S 15 Degrees West by D^r (Walkup) 80 perches to a Stone Thence S 75 Degrees West by the Land of James Deasly 129 perches to a Stone Thence S 30 Degrees West by Vacant Land 36 perches to a Stone Thence S 18 Degrees West by D^r James Deasly 26 perches to an Ash by a small Branch of Brandywine Thence up said Branch on y^e several Courses thereof 18 perches to a small Chesnut &c
 (the 3rd Day of April 1745) Sam Wrightfoot

P.S. The above mentioned Survey Includes Land Granted to George Keligan by Warrant of y^e 17th of August 1744 he having sold to S^r Deasly. S. L.
