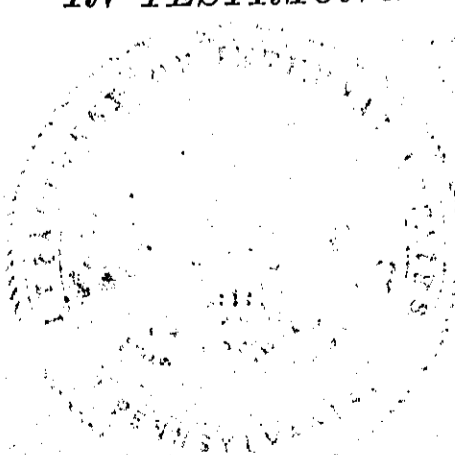


A draught of a tract of Land situate in Maccungy Township in the County of Northampton (formerly Bucks) and Province of Pennsylvania, Containing Fifty Acres and 25 perches of Land together with the usual allowance at six per Cent for Roads. That was formerly surveyed by Henry Vandersluis into Christian Road, in Pursuance of a Warrant granted to George Hooper dated at Philadelphia on the 22<sup>d</sup> Day of November Anno 1750. --

Resurveyed on the 29<sup>th</sup> Day of November Anno 1763 into the above named Christian Road
