



A Draught of a Tract of Land called Konover situate on the South Side of the North East branch of Susquehanna between the Konover of Stoke and Sahawannack adjoining to Lucien Land surveyed to Adolph Gillman by John Wolf containing three hundred & one acres and  $\frac{3}{4}$  with the usual allowance of 6 per cent for roads surveyed for Martin Gillman the 16<sup>th</sup> November 1769.
