



In pursuance of a Warrant granted ^{to} Simon Duffner dated November 30th 1786 surveyed on the 26th day of January 1829 the above described tract of land containing two hundred and eighty two acres one hundred and fifty seven perches and the allowance proportioned at six per Cent for roads &c situate in formerly ^{now Senickly} Mount Pleasant Township Westmoreland County on a branch of Senickly Creek.
