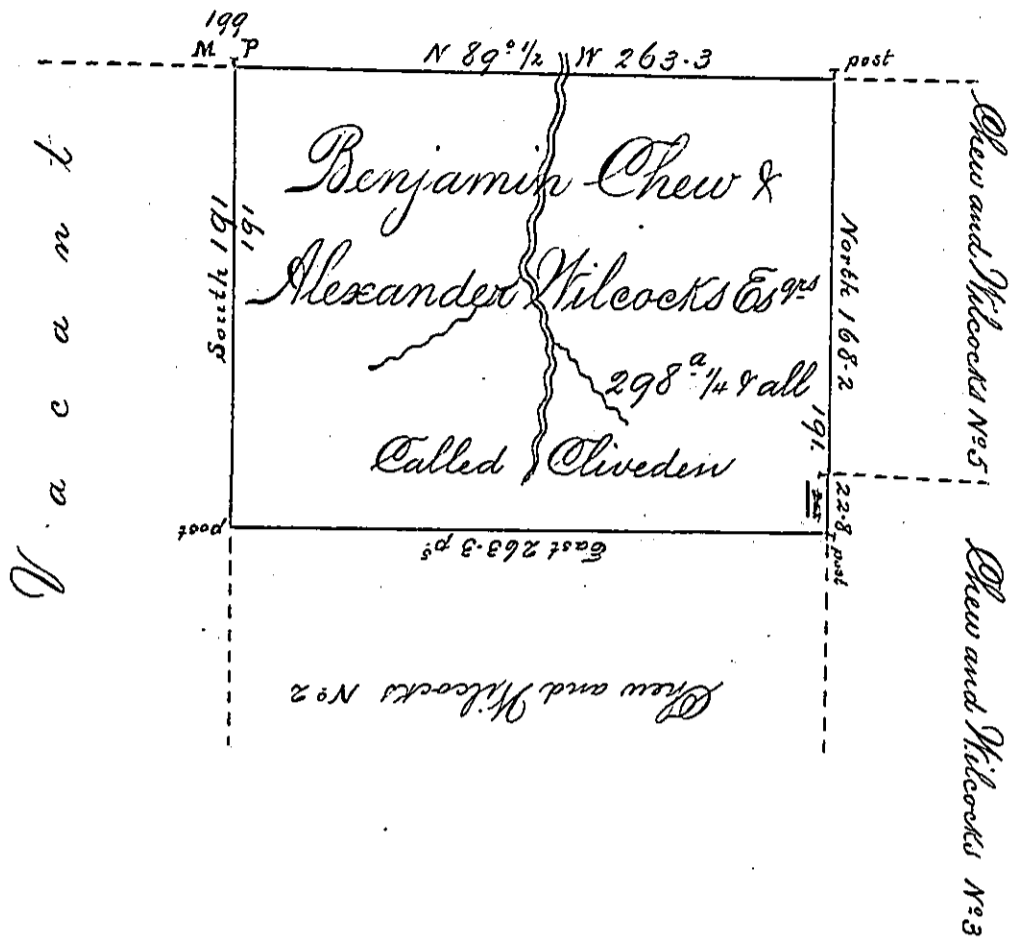


M a r y l a n d
