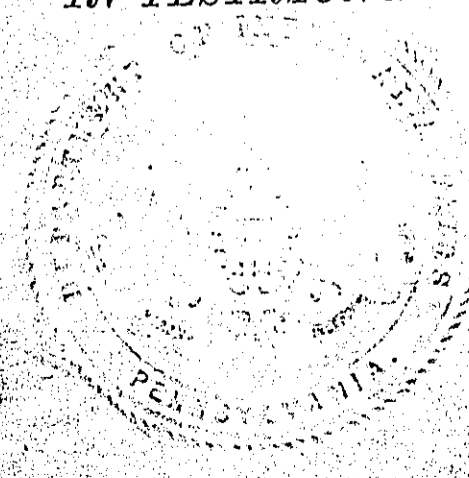


Land Settled
