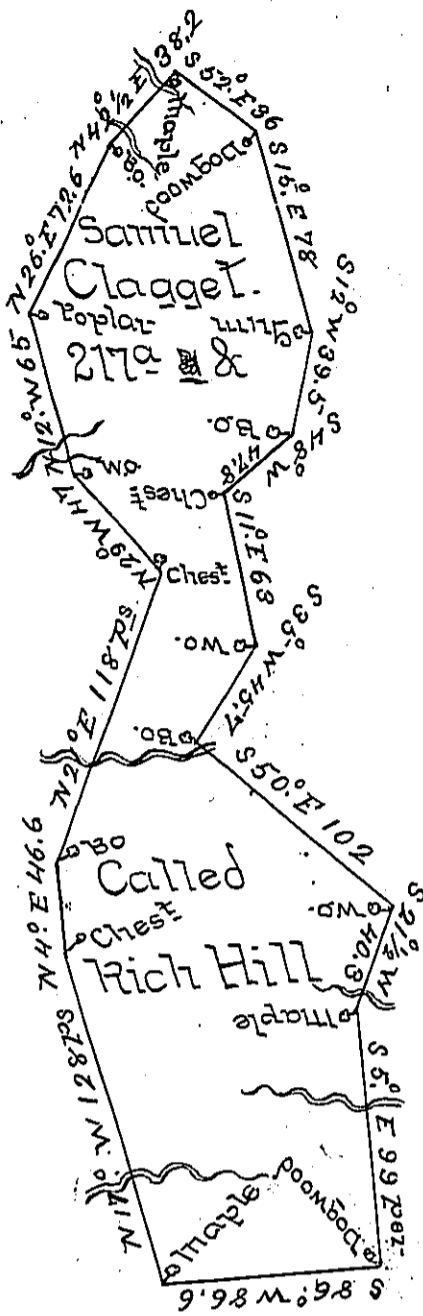


A R-O-C-K-H
