



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Hon^{ble} Proprietaries bearing Date the 5th Day of April Anno 1741 I have Survey'd and laid out unto Jacob Fry on Natimers Creek in the County of Lancaster on the West Side Susquehanna river one hundred Acs of land with allow^s of six Percent Beginning at a Spanish Oak Thence North Twenty Degrees Easterly one hundred and sixty perches to a Post Thence South Seventy Degrees Easterly one hundred and six perches to a Gum Tree Thence South Twenty Degrees Westerly one hundred and sixty Perches to a Spanish Oak Thence North Seventy Degrees Westerly one hundred & six perches to the Place of Beginning
