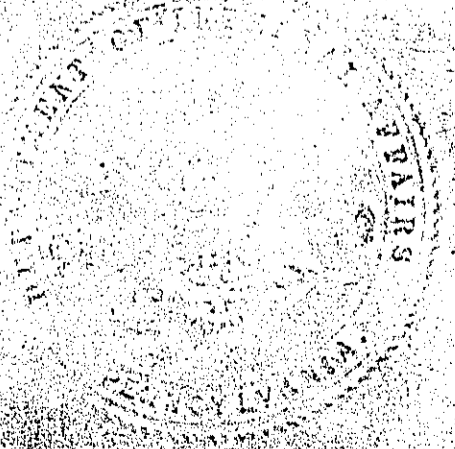


A Draught of a Tract of Land situate in Martick Township in the County of Lancaster Containing two Hundred and thirty Acres and Allowance of six Per Cent for Roads &c Surveyed the 15th day of Apr^l 1751 for Andrew McCleery in pursuance of a Warrant bearing date the 1st of March 1749/50 protracted from the field Book of Thomas Cookson Esq late Deputy Surveyor of Lancaster County and Calculated by Leo. Stephenson one of the Executors of Thos. Cookson Esq
 To Nicholas Scull Esq Sr.

A Covenant was entered by W^m Deman against the Return of the above Survey the parties were directed to meet on the 14th of Feb^r 1760 before Rich^d Peters Esq Secretary &c who dismissed the Covenant and ordered the Draught to be Returned
