



Draft of a tract of land surveyed the 2^d of October 1805 for Thomas Willson situate in Pitt township Allegheny County on Genl Forbes's old road, containing forty three acres and thirty six perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c being part of a larger tract that was surveyed on the 20th of April 1770 by Robert McCrea Deputy Surveyor of the district for William Menoch by virtue of two locations dated the 3^d day of April 1769 numbered 493 and 2761 and by him returned into the Surveyor Generals Office - the above described part of which by several conveyance is now the estate of the said Thomas Willson
