



The above Draught Represents, An Island in the River Susquehanna opposit to Philip Gallagher on the one side and lands belonging to Writes on the other, about ten Rods above big Island, in Manor township Lancaster County Containing two Acres, and three perches neat Measure, surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant dated the Nineteenth day of March, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and three (1803) granted to Jacob Kinthart This 3<sup>rd</sup> day of November Anno Domini 1823.
